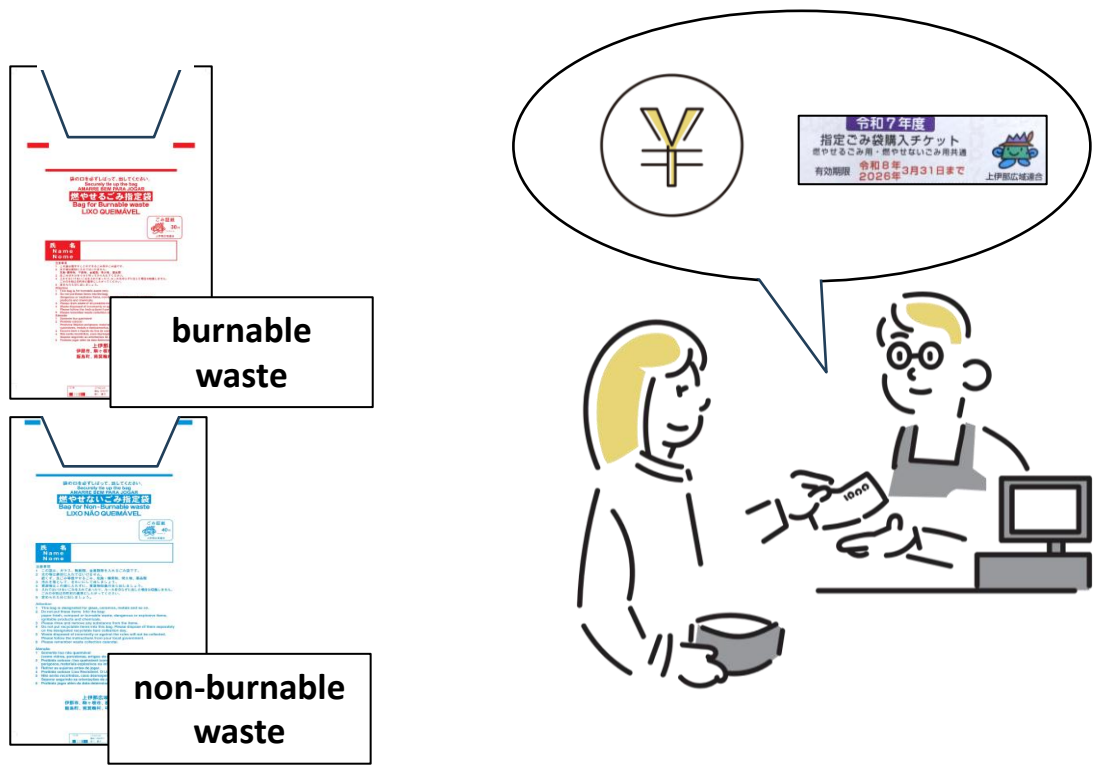

How to buy designated garbage bags

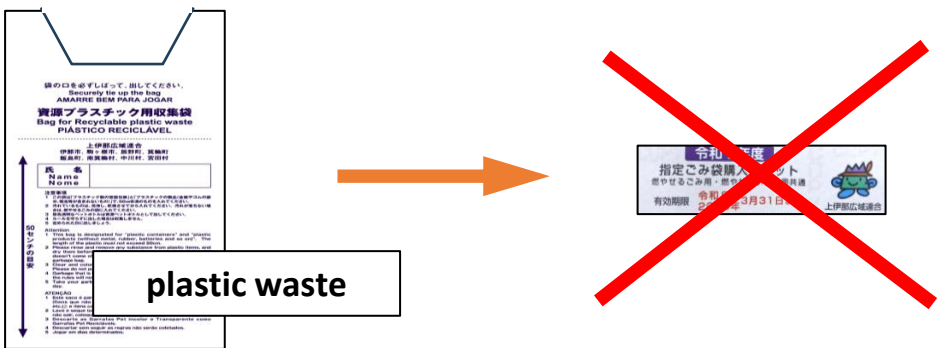
Designated garbage bags for burnable waste, non-burnable waste, and plastic waste can be purchased at supermarkets, convenience stores, drugstores, etc.



You will need a ticket and money to purchase the designated bags for burnable and non-burnable waste.

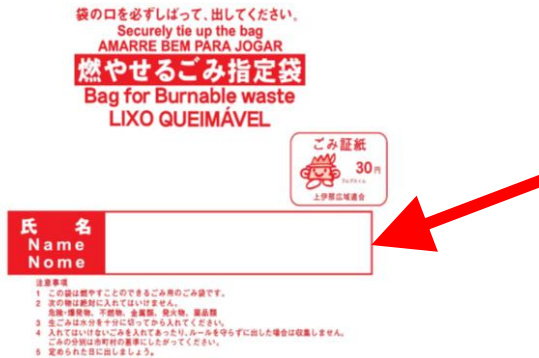


You don't need a ticket when buying designated garbage bags for plastic waste.



How to take out the trash

1. Write your name on the designated garbage bag.



2. Separate your trash.



3. Put your trash in the designated trash bag.



4. Tie the opening of the bag so that the trash inside doesn't fall out.



5. Take your trash to the designated collection point on the designated day.



warning



The place where you dispose of your trash differs depending on where you live.

If you don't know where your trash collection point is, please ask your neighbors or the local government office.

Illegal dumping is a crime.

Please absolutely do not do that.

Please take your trash to the collection point between 6:00 AM and 8:00 AM.



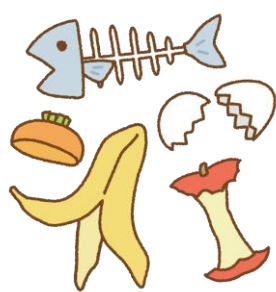
Put your trash in the designated bag with red lettering.

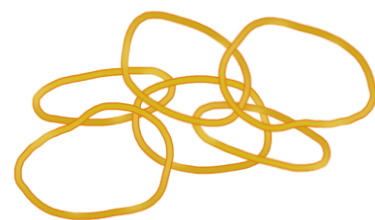
Dirty plastic waste

Put your trash in the designated bag with blue lettering.



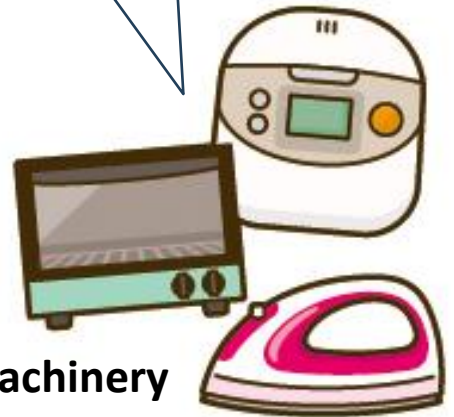

Wash it thoroughly, dry it, and then throw it away.

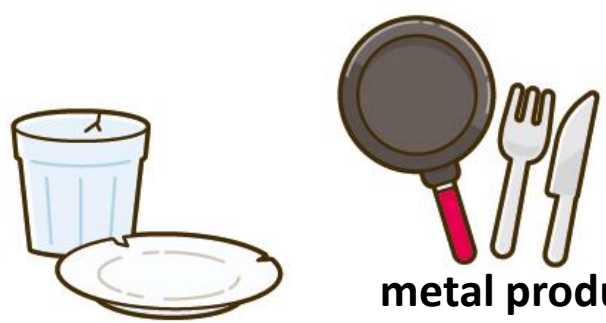

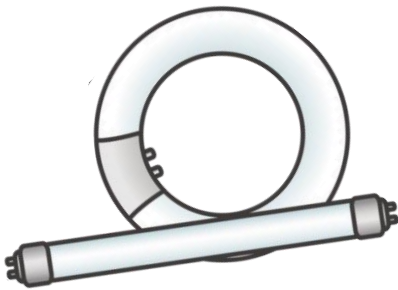

- ② Remove the plastic label.
- ③ Place your waste into the blue containers or nets at the garbage collection point, separating it by type.



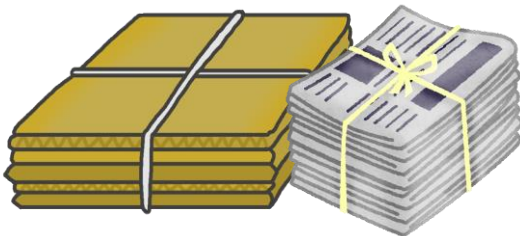
fluorescent tube

- ① Separate by type.
- ② Tie it up with string and throw it away.

***Please put small pieces of paper together in a paper bag before discarding them.**

- ① Use it all until it's gone.
 - ② Break it down and throw it away as non-burnable waste.

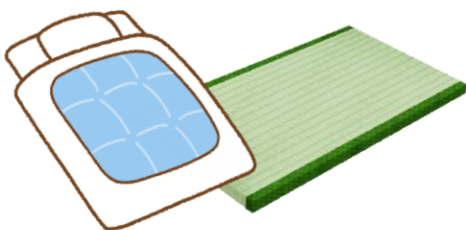
- ① Use it all until it's gone.

 - ③ Dispose of it as non-burnable waste.

bulky waste

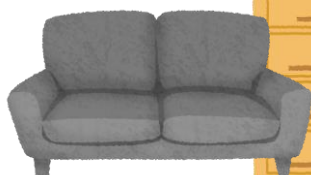

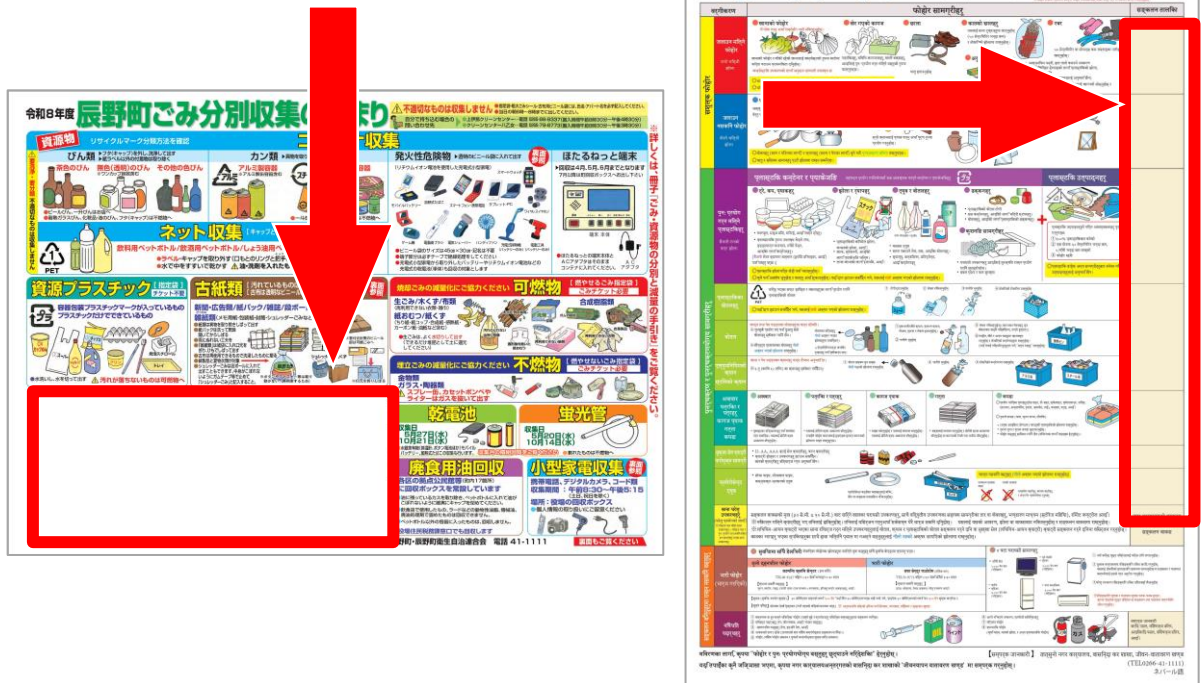
